ARTIST STATEMENT

My work exists at the intersection of music, technology, and perception, exploring the boundaries between sound, structure, and human cognition.



As a composer and researcher, I integrate unconventional methodologies—ranging from data transformation to experimental notation—into my creative process. My compositions challenge traditional notions of form, inviting new ways of experiencing sound as a dynamic, evolving entity.

I am particularly interested in the interplay between order and unpredic ability, constructing immersive sonic environments that respond to both structured design and organic intuition. Through extended techniques, sensor-based installations, and generative systems, I seek to push the limits of performance and audience interaction. My work is equally informed by scientific inquiry and artistic exploration, drawing from the physical properties of sound, the perception of time, and the sensory experience of listening.

At its core, my artistic practice is a dialogue—between past and future, human and machine, structure and improvisation. Whether composing for traditional ensembles, designing kinetic sound sculptures, or developing interactive systems, I aim to blur the lines between disciplines, inviting listeners to engage with music in ways that are both analytical and deeply personal.
