This position runs **mid-April through mid-October**, with shifts **Wednesday through Saturday, 4:00 PM – 9:00 PM**. There is opportunity to join our regular front of house team the remainder of the year.

The outdoor bar will be a lively extension of the Theater’s atmosphere—welcoming audiences, artists, and neighbors to connect. We’re looking for a bartender who not only serves great drinks, but will help shape this space into a vibrant community hub. You’ll play a key role in creating a warm, inviting experience for patrons and encouraging repeat visits.

This position is ideal for an experienced hospitality professional who enjoys evening work but wants a manageable, steady schedule without late nights. It’s a great fit for someone who values quality interactions with guests in a relaxed, community-oriented setting.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities:

- Prepare and serve beer, wine, and simple cocktails in compliance with PA Liquor Control laws, RAMP training standards and New Hazlett house rules for alcohol service.
- Engage guests with friendly, professional service and conversation.
- Handle cash and electronic payments accurately, reconcile sales, and maintain financial integrity.



- Monitor stock levels, manage inventory, and communicate supply needs proactively.
- Setup, restock, and close the outdoor bar efficiently each evening.
- Maintain a clean, organized, and safe work area.
- Contribute to building the bar's following through positive word-of-mouth and excellent hospitality.

Preferred Experience:

- Two years of bartending or other hospitality position in a fast-paced environment
- Experience working in outdoor or pop-up event spaces
- Experience managing inventory and communicating supply needs
- Familiarity with opening, closing, and cash management procedures

- Ability to communicate with a broad range of patrons
- Ability to calmly and professionally address occasional guest concerns, ensuring a positive and welcoming atmosphere
- Ability to problem-solve, and able to quickly identify and provide recommendations on issues



- Comfortable working independently outdoors during evening shifts, maintaining energy, focus, and a friendly attitude
- Strong organizational and time management skills with the ability to multitask and reprioritize

Licenses or Certifications:

- RAMP certification is required; if you are not currently certified, the New Hazlett will cover the cost of certification.
- CPR / First Aid training will be provided annually

Travel Requirements:

- Access to reliable transportation required

Physical, mental demands and working conditions:

- The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job: An employee in this position must be able to communicate well with others in person and be able to communicate via handheld radio.
- The employee must be able to understand and solve problems, interpret and analyze data, concentrate, use available technological resources and systems, such as a cash register and computer programs, multi-task, prioritize, and interact with multiple individuals to complete essential tasks.
- An employee in this position is frequently required to move throughout the workplace, sit, stand, walk, carry up to 60 pounds, climb stairs, balance, stoop, kneel, crouch and crawl.
- This position will stock product on shelving



Working Hours:

- Wednesday's through Saturday's from 4:00pm to 9:00pm from mid-April to mid-October
- Shifts may be moved indoors based on weather conditions
- The outdoor bar will not be open if the theater is rented out for a private event such as a wedding, company party, etc.

Compensation:
